Reilly Arts Center Dedicates AdventHealth Mainstage in Celebration of Expanded Partnership

OCALA, Fla. (June 25, 2025) – The Reilly Arts Center hosted a dedication ceremony on June 25 to unveil the newly named AdventHealth Mainstage, marking the beginning of an expanded partnership between AdventHealth Ocala and the Reilly Arts Center. This milestone sponsorship deepens the long-standing relationship between the organizations and reinforces their shared commitment to the health and cultural vitality of the Ocala community.

Board members, supporters of the arts, and leadership from the health system gathered to celebrate AdventHealth Ocala's impactful investment of \$1 million over the next ten years to support the Ocala Symphony Orchestra and its home the Reilly Arts Center. The gift will support the operations of the center and allow the Reilly to continue delivering inspiring performances, educational programs, and community-centered initiatives through music and the performing arts.

Since then, the Reilly has continued to expand its programming and footprint to include the NOMA Black Box theatre and the Ocala Symphony Orchestra's Community Music Conservatory, which offers music lessons to students of all ages and skill levels.
