THE 50TH SEASON OF THE OCALA SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA ANNOUNCED

OCALA, Fla. (May 21, 2025) – The Ocala Symphony Orchestra is pleased to announce their 2025-2026 season with timeless masterworks, exciting repertoire, and world-class soloists under the baton of Maestro Matthew Wardell. The 50th season begins June 29, 2025, with Red, White, and OSO Blue, and subscription performances begin October 2025. The upcoming season will feature six subscription concerts, seven special events, and four chamber music concerts for guests of all ages. Unless otherwise indicated, events are held at the Reilly Arts Center located at 500 NE 9th St. Ocala, FL 34470.

The Symphony's special concert selection is on sale now, including the annual Red, White, and OSO Blue celebration, Nutcracker with live orchestra, and the new chamber music series in the NOMA Black Box at the Reilly Arts Center.
